Q.1:

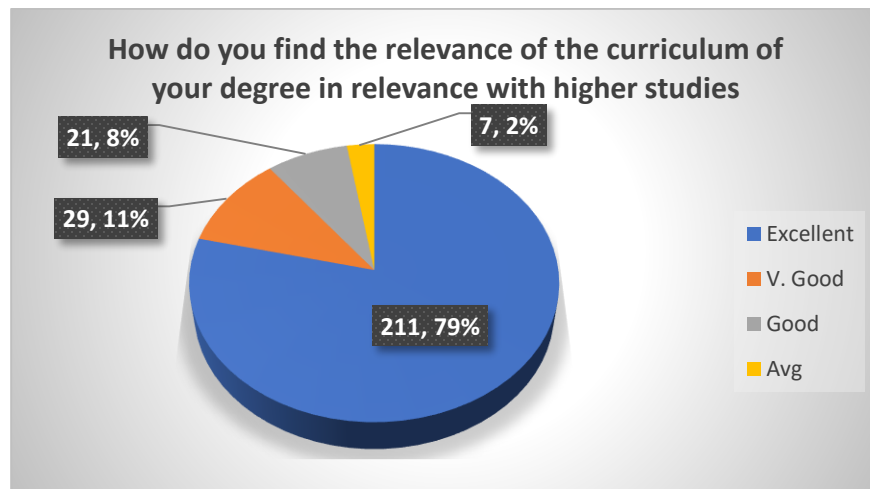


Chart 1: Relevance of the curriculum of your degree in relevance with higher studies

Q.2:

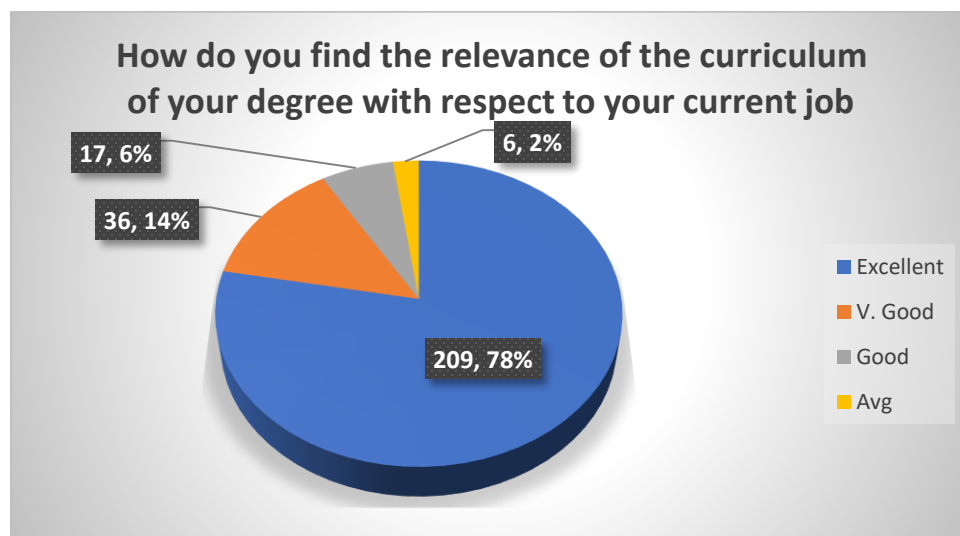


Chart 2: Relevance of the curriculum of your degree with respect to your current job

Q.3:

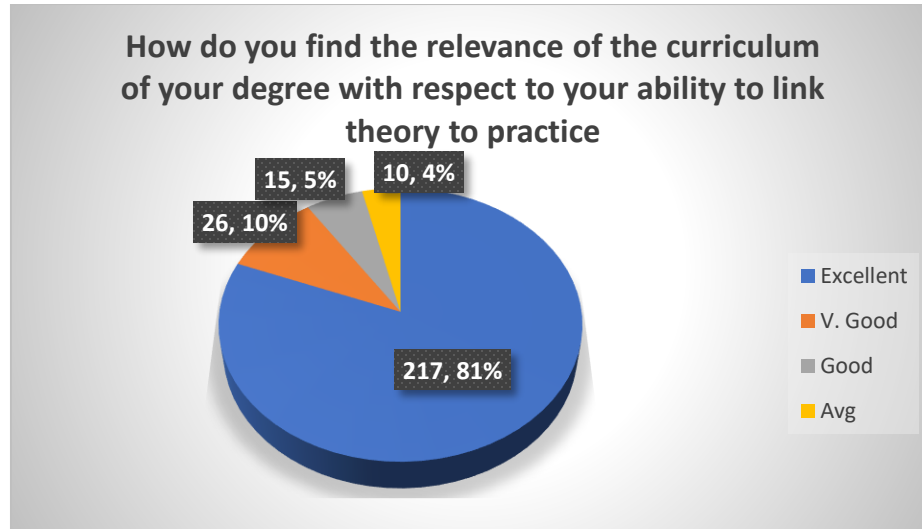


Chart 3: Relevance of the curriculum of your degree with respect to your ability to link theory to practice

Q.4:

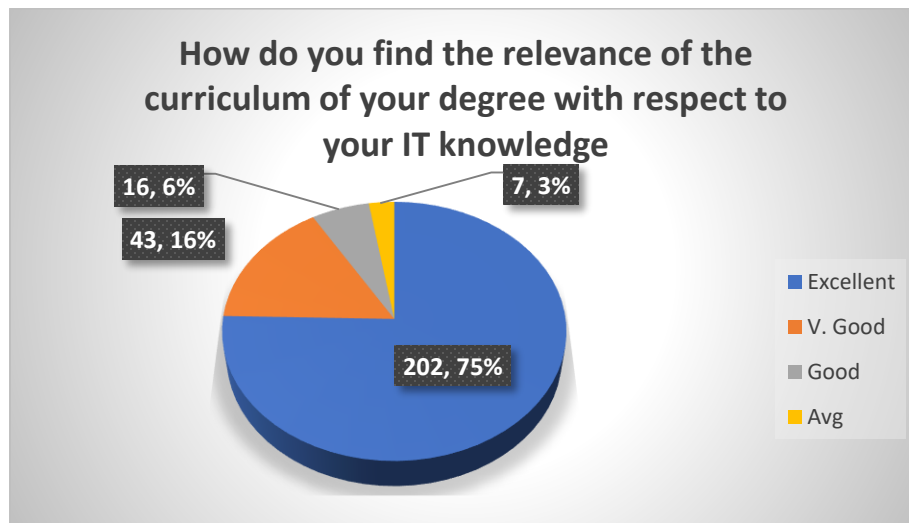


Chart 4: relevance of the curriculum of your degree with respect to your IT knowledge
